### Level of complexity

- Simple

### Objectives

- Engaging in self-reflection on travel preferences and destination choices.

### Knowledge and skills

- The students can write answers to the given question and continue the list with their own ideas.

### Duration

- 10 to 20 minutes

### Resources

- None

### Preparation

- None

### Procedure

- To introduce the topic of travelling, the popular game "I'm packing my suitcase ..." can be played in various modified versions.
- The teacher chooses the version in advance.
- Standard version: I'm packing my suitcase and taking with me ...
- Other possible versions:

⇒ I'm packing my suitcase to visit ... (name the place)

⇒ I'm packing my suitcase because ... (state intention to travel)

⇒ I'm packing my suitcase and travelling with ... (name means of transportation)

⇒ etc.

- One student gives the appropriate answer. The next person repeats the previous answer and adds their own. This process continues in order.
- The game stops if someone makes a mistake when repeating the answers. You can then restart the game – either in the same way or with a different variation.
- Keep playing as long as you like!
